



Offroad Motorsport UK – Child Welfare Policy

The UK's 4 nations – England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales – have their own child protection system and laws to help protect children from abuse and neglect.

Each nation has a framework of legislation, guidance and practice to identify children who are at risk of harm, and take action to protect those children and prevent further abuse occurring.

Your primary responsibility is managing and reporting concerns about children and for putting into place procedures to safeguard children within the Club.

- ❖ Assist the Organization in fulfilling its responsibilities to safeguard children and young people
- ❖ Liaise with the relevant agencies on individual cases in an urgent situation
- ❖ Provide advice and support to the club regarding concerns about behavior that is harmful to children
- ❖ Maintain records about concerns raised
- ❖ Ensure confidentiality is maintained at all times
- ❖ Promote anti-discriminatory practice within the club

If you think a child is in immediate danger – call the Police

If you are worried about a child who is not in immediate danger please raise your concern's with the Association who will work with the Local Authority to make arrangements to identify and support the child at possible risk of harm.
